Transform the sentence.

There are four types of sentences:
Declarative – makes a statement
Interrogative – asks a question
Exclamatory – expresses strong ideas
Imperative – gives a command

1) The cat is on the step. (D) -> (In)

2) Is it time to go? (In) -> (D)

3) This is my best friend. (D) -> (E)

4) Turn the lamp on. (Im) -> (In)

5) You finished your work. (D) -> (Im)

The teacher sings
a song. (D),

Does the teacher
sing a song? (In),

The teacher sings
a song! (E),

Sing a song. (Im).

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Answers

- 1) The cat is on the step. (D) -> (In) Is the cat on the step?
- 2) Is it time to go? (In) -> (D) It is time to go.
- 3) This is my best friend. (D) -> (E) This is my best friend!
- 4) Turn on the lamp. (Im) -> (In) Did you turn on the lamp?
- 5) You finished your work. (D) -> (Im) Finish your work.
