Grade 2 Word Problems Worksheet

Ms. Hudson is getting her cooking class ready. She has 4 students in this class, and they are going to make double chocolate muffins.

1. Ms. Hudson printed two sheets of recipes for each student. How many sheets did she print in total?
2. Each student will be making 5 muffins. Together with the 5 muffins that Ms. Hudson will be making, how many muffins will be made in total?
3. Ms. Hudson measured 4 cups of flour for each student. How many cups of flour does she measured for all the students?



4. She takes out 3 boxes of eggs from the fridge. If there are 6 eggs in each box, how many eggs are there?

5. Each bar of chocolate can be broken into 10 cubes. How many cubes are there if there are 2 bars of chocolate?

6. Write the number sentence with multiplication that fits this: "At the end of the class, each student took home 3 of their muffins. The students took home a total of 12 muffins."

Answers

1. $4 \times 2 = 8$
She printed 8 sheets in total.
2. $5 \times 5 = 25$
25 muffins will be made in total.
3. $4 \times 4 = 16$
She measured 16 cups of flour.
4. $3 \times 6 = 18$
There are 18 eggs.
5. $2 \times 10 = 20$
There are 20 cubes of chocolate.
6. $4 \times 3 = 12$
