Reading Comprehension Worksheet

A parent or tutor should read to the student and he	elp the student to record their

If something is *true*, or it *really happened*, it is a **fact**.

If something is *what someone thinks or believes*, it is an **opinion**.

Listen to the story. Think about what parts are **fact** and what parts are **opinion**.

Purple is Mack's favorite color. Mack uses his purple marker to draw purple cows under purple trees. He draws purple people playing with purple puppies. He thinks his purple pictures look funny. One day, Mack's purple marker went dry. He looked at his other markers. Then he went and got his purple crayon. None of the other colors were quite as funny as purple.

Circle the word "fact" if it is *true* or it *really happened* in the story. Circle the word "opinion" if it is *what someone thinks or believes*.

- Mack thinks his purple pictures look fact opinion funny.

Robert's mom says it is silly to believe that a shirt can be lucky, but Robert is still sure that it is.
