

# Carnivore, herbivore, or omnivore?

## Grade 3 Science Worksheet



Animals can be classified by what they eat.

Herbivores eat only plants. Carnivores eat only meat.

Omnivores eat both.

For each trait, write *herbivore*, *carnivore*, or *omnivore*. You may need to write more than one answer for some items.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Long front teeth for chewing through bark
- \_\_\_\_\_ Long canine teeth to rip meat
- \_\_\_\_\_ Both sharp and flat teeth
- \_\_\_\_\_ Only eat plants
- \_\_\_\_\_ Only eat meat
- \_\_\_\_\_ Eat both plants and meat
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hooves
- \_\_\_\_\_ Claws
- \_\_\_\_\_ Eyes on the side to look for danger
- \_\_\_\_\_ Eyes in front to look for prey

## Answers

For each trait, write *herbivore*, *carnivore*, or *omnivore*. You may need to write more than one answer for some items.

<u>herbivore</u>	Flat teeth for grinding leaves
<u>herbivore</u>	Long front teeth for chewing through bark
<u>carnivore</u>	Long canine teeth to rip meat
<u>omnivore</u>	Both sharp and flat teeth
<u>herbivore</u>	Only eat plants
<u>carnivore</u>	Only eat meat
<u>omnivore</u>	Eat both plants and meat
<u>herbivore</u>	Hooves
<u>carnivore</u>	Claws
<u>omnivore</u>	Eyes on the side to look for danger
<u>carnivore</u>	Eyes in front to look for prey
