the result or outcome of a cause	nail	a piece of ground adjoining a building or house
pull or rip (something) apart or to pieces with force	effect	have a strong effect on someone or something
a spike-shaped metal fastener used for joining wood or similar materials	yard	a flame or something used to create fire
moving to or placing in a particular position	tear	the thin, horny plate at the ends of fingers and toes
an electronic screen that shows graphics or text	putting	a performance, show, or event intended for public entertainment
a unit of linear measure equal to 3 feet	light	a drop of clear salty liquid produced from a person's eye when he/she cries
the force or energy of a collision of two objects	impact	trying to hit a golf ball into a hole by striking it gently so that it rolls across the green
a source of illumination	display	the lighting, sound, or scenery used in a play, movie, or broadcast
