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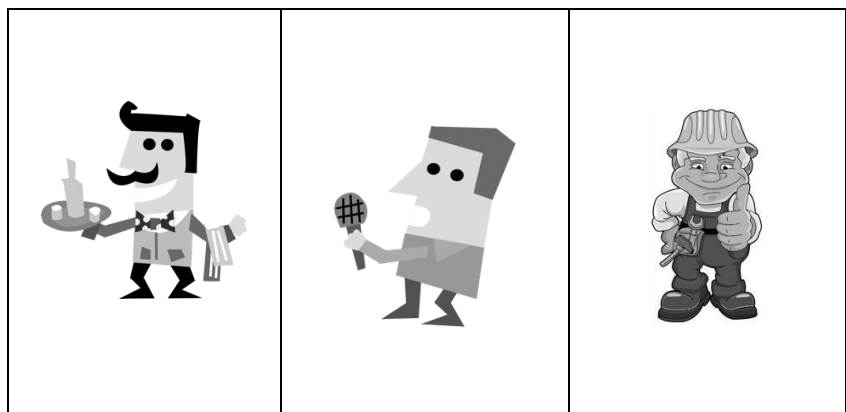
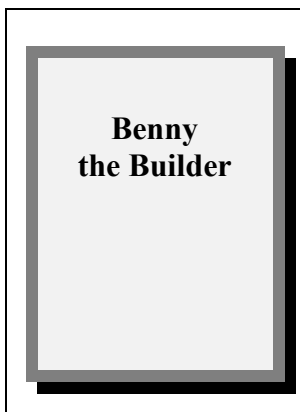
Making a **prediction** is guessing *what happens next*.

The title of a book can help you guess what you will see inside it.




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Listen to the title of the book. Then look at the pictures to guess what *you will see inside the book*.
