I (know / no) you must be tired, so I will let you rest.

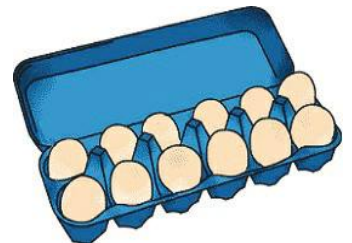
(Hour / Our) school library has many books.
