The **high-speed** train **arrived** at the **crowded** station.
5. The rain falls on the city.
The **heavy** rain **poured down** on the **busy** city.
6. The moon shines in the night sky.
The **bright** moon **glows** in the **night** sky.
7. The horse runs in the field.
The **majestic** horse **gallops** in the **grassy** field.
8. The girl skips down the sidewalk.
The **cheerful** girl **skips** down the **empty** sidewalk.
