

Subtraction (single digits)

Grade 1 Word Problems Worksheet

Baker Jane had a busy day last Sunday.

1. She had 6 bags of flour but used up 4 bags on Sunday. How many bags of flour did she have left?
2. She ordered 8 bags of sugar, but the supplier said they can only deliver 5 bags of sugar on Monday. The rest would be delivered on Wednesday. How many bags of sugar will be delivered on Wednesday?
3. She had 7 boxes of butter, but 3 boxes melted on Saturday because the fridge was not working. How many boxes of butter did she have left?



4. She baked 9 boxes of cookies and 3 boxes of muffins. Then she sold 2 boxes of cookies. How many boxes of cookies were left?

5. There were 4 boxes of muffin cups in the storage room. After Baker Jane took 3 boxes of muffin cups to the kitchen, how many boxes of muffin cups were left in the storage room?

6. Write the subtraction sentence that fits this:
“There were 5 cinnamon rolls and 7 croissants.
There are 2 more croissants than cinnamon rolls.”

Answers

1. $6 - 4 = 2$
There were 2 bags of flour left.
2. $8 - 5 = 3$
3 bags of sugar would be delivered on Wednesday.
3. $7 - 3 = 4$
She had 4 boxes of butter left.
4. $9 - 2 = 7$
There were 7 boxes of cookies left.
5. $4 - 3 = 1$
There were 1 box of muffin cups left in the storage room.
6. $7 - 5 = 2$
