A red line connects 'vol' to 'ca' and 'ca' to 'no', forming the word 'volcano'.

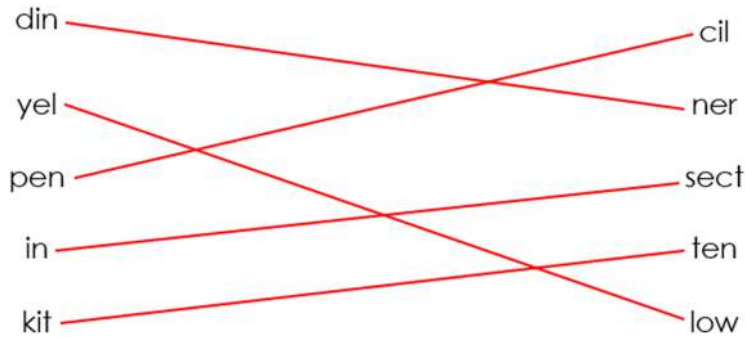

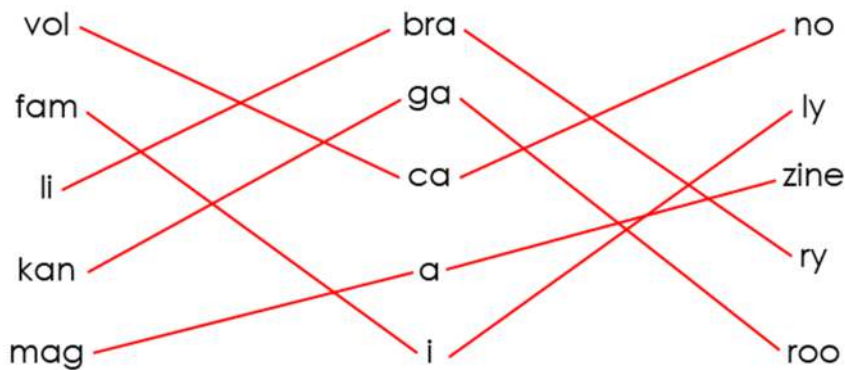
