

Cause and effect

Grade 1 Reading Comprehension Worksheet



Cause and effect are about how one thing can cause something else to happen. The **cause** is <u>why</u> something happened. The **effect** is <u>what</u> happened.

Read the **cause**. Circle the most likely **effect**.

Cause	Effect

Cause	Effect
 S. Ryan left his sweatshirt outside in the rain. What happened because Ryan left his sweatshirt outside in the rain? 	Ryan's sweatshirt got wet.
	Ryan went to the movies.

Here is a cause: John's shoelace came untied.
 What might be an effect?
