When we **compare** two things, we tell how they are **alike**. When we **contrast** two things, we tell how they are **different**.

1. Read or listen to the story. As you do, think about how Wiggly and Bloop are <u>alike</u> and <u>different</u>.

Wiggly and Bloop are two monsters who live in Monsterland. Wiggly is a furry, blue monster. He is short with lots of arms that all move at the same time. He is a shy monster who is afraid to speak to strangers.

Bloop is a furry, purple monster. He is tall, and his body makes silly noises when he moves. He is a friendly monster who loves to meet new people.

Even though they are very different,
Wiggly and Bloop are best friends. They
met when they were three years old, and
they have been friends ever since! They love
to play at Monsterland Park together.
