Grade 1 Reading Worksheet



When we **compare** two things, we tell how they are **alike**. When we **contrast** two things, we tell how they are **different**.

1. Read or listen to the story. As you do, think about how authors and singers are <u>alike</u> and <u>different</u>.

Authors and singers both tell stories, but they do it in different ways. Authors use words to write books or stories that people can read. Singers use their voices to sing songs that people can listen to.

Authors spend a lot of time writing and editing their work. Singers practice singing and sometimes play instruments. They also may write their own songs. Authors might work quietly at a desk, while singers often sing on stage for an audience.

Both authors and singers share their ideas and feelings with others, whether it's through books or songs!
