Grade 1 Reading Worksheet



The **plot** is what happens in a story, including the beginning, middle and end.

1. Read or listen to the story.

One afternoon, Lily and her friends decided to play a game of hide-and-seek in her backyard. Lily was chosen to be “It,” so she closed her eyes and started counting. Her friends ran around, each looking for the perfect hiding spot.

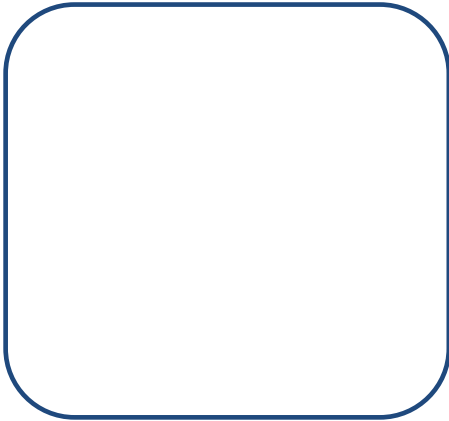

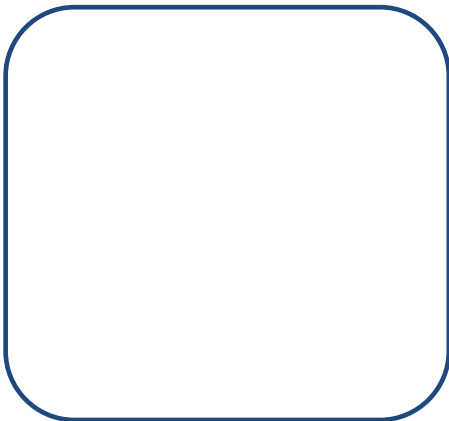


2. Fill in the boxes with pictures and words to describe what happened in the story's beginning, middle and end.

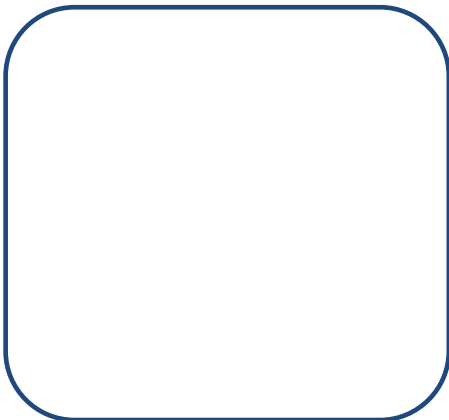
What happened in the **beginning** of the story?
